Vasati – based on the natural laws of Vastu


Vasati is an integral architectural concept. Since millennia, houses, temples, and even whole cities are built by this concept in India. It's basis are the natural laws of spatial energy, and this knowledge is used to bring the living space in resonance with nature and its inhabitants. The house is like a man's second body.

It is a lens focussing the natural environmental influences. The quality of the living space influences our physical health as well as our mental and emotional status.

We may think that environmental factors could in any way influence our health, for example the Earth's magnetic field, the subtle energies from the Earth and Sun, the paths of Sun and Moon as well their gravitation, etc. All these influences taken together, define the quality of a room we are living in. diseases seems to be furthered, while a strong bioenergetic living field strengthens the power of resistance of its inhabitants. The old Indian geomancy Vastu has been shaped into a scientific system after millennia of experience and observation. With this you can find out the effects of environmental influences on man. the Sthapatis, the south Indian masterarchitects of the Vishvakarma clan. Each region and culture uses its own measuring systems and by choosing a particular system one gets into resonance with the energy of the respective culture where

this system is rooted. system and the basic measure of the Sthapatis is derived from the circumferences of the earth, the moon and the sun. It resonates with the ancient and famous vastu structures of Chidambaram and Shri Rangam.
